



## Sovereignty Information Standards

WHEREAS sovereignty information is so powerful, and because it can result in extreme consequences such as jail or worse, Ben Lowrey has felt it important to create a list of criteria, to help truth seekers to find the best sources of information and raise the standards of teaching and disclosure within the sovereignty movement.

If you are learning information about Law, Sovereignty, Freedom, be sure to learn from people who have achieved results from the Section A Victory list. A person ought to only teach things they have achieved. Stick to information which is proven.

It is Ben Lowrey's opinion that prudent students achieve better results by learning from winning teachers, and winning teaches get pride and enjoyment from openly telling people about their victories, yet weasels and liars will vehemently detest these Sovereignty Information Standards.

Anybody who commits an act from Section B through E without having achieved a relevant Section A victory, has committed an act of deception and is in violation of these standards.

## Section A. Victory List.

(“John Smith has achieved a AX victory on the S.I.S. list”)

### **Lawsuit where you're the defendant**

A1 - Civil. The plaintiff withdrew their own complaint.

A2 - Criminal. The prosecutor dropped the charges.

A3 - The Judge dismissed the case.

A4 - You win the Judgment either summarily or at trial

### **Lawsuit where you're the Plaintiff**

A5 - Your defendant pays you a settlement before trial

A6 - You win at trial and your defendant is ordered to pay you.

A7 - They pay you a settlement without you even needing to actually file suit.

### **Unsecured Debt (including Tax)**

A8 - It's been over a year any you haven't heard anything.

A9 - They wrote and confirmed that it's dropped / settled. No further action is required.

### **A4V**

A10(a) - They sent you a statement of account showing the credit and zero balance.  
(If it's not this then it's probably just an A8 or A9. Unless you received an A10 then there is no proof that your A4V was ever actually processed by IRS/Treasury, so it cannot be called an A4V. There is no reason to presume it was monetized).

A10(b) – Same as above but you issued and tendered some other kind of financial instrument rather than an A4V (such as Promissory Note, Bond, etc)

### **Parking Tickets / infractions**

A11 - You receive a letter saying they are dropping it and confirming that no further action is required

### **Mortgage / Secured Debt**

A12 - You settled the debt, you perfected the title free and clear, you have peaceful possession of the property, no pending lawsuit, no dispute of title, non ongoing attempts to evict or repossess.

### **Jail**

A13 - You got yourself or somebody else out of jail

A14 - You filed a petition for a writ of HC, you were brought before the court and it resulted in your release.

### **Lien**

A15 - Sold a lien to a debt collector or investment banker or similar.

A16(a) - Got the sheriff to enforce your private admin process / lien, sheriff seized your debtor's property.

A16(b) – You collected money on the lien in some other way, such as when lien property was eventually sold.

### **Driving**

A17 – The authorities have openly acknowledged that you have a right to travel with no plates and/or that you're not subject to statutes and they knowingly let you carry on. You can drive right up to the cops a purposely get their attention and they openly acknowledge that they have no power to stop you.

A18 – Routinely driving without plates / with private plates / no statutory insurance / no drivers license etc. and you repeatedly get pulled over, you repeatedly talk yourself out of it, they repeatedly let you go.

### **Miscellaneous**

A19 - Some other significant result

## Section B.

### Unintentional reckless information.

These scenarios are dangerous because they are incomplete. These are situations which are yet to be resolved or yet to be fully tested and are likely to result criminal charges at some point in the future.

Anybody who claims to have achieved any of the following without having achieved a Section A victory is dispensing potentially dangerous information and you are encouraged to exercise great caution. You could end up being arrested if you attempt to emulate these types of scenarios.

These situation are ticking time bombs and should not be considered victories.

B.1. – Has been driving without plates / with private plates / no statutory insurance / no drivers license etc. Hasn't ever been pulled over yet.

(I call this scenario "Mr Invincible")

B.2. - Got pulled over whilst driving without plates / with private plates / with no statutory insurance / with no drivers license etc. Was let go by the traffic cop without charge.

B.3. – Or some similar scenario

## Section C

### Passively reckless information.

Usually passed within informal discussion groups, online or in meetings.  
Meaningless ramblings presented as if it's powerful information.

The following scenarios have no legal significance. Exercise great caution because these topics generate feelings of over confidence but ultimately can lead to serious consequences. If you hear these type of things, ensure you are learning from somebody who has also achieved Section A Victories.

C1 – “They acted unlawfully but it's ok because now I'm going to lien them.”

C2 – “I have several liens worth millions of dollars against several government agencies / banks / police / corporations etc.”

C3 – “I sent the notice of default and they didn't respond so that means they have tacitly acquiesced to my terms and conditions.”

C4 – “We had a hearing this afternoon, the judge abandoned the court and so we dismissed the case ourselves”

C5 – “I appointed the judge as the trustee, I informed the court I am the executor of the estate, he didn't do as I instructed and so he has committed a breach of trust and is now personally liable for the charges.” (or something similar)

C6 – “I got arrested but now I'm going to give them hell and sue them”

C7 – Something similar to any of the above

## Section D

### Actively reckless information.

Usually presented by somebody who is representing them self as an expert or teacher.  
Complicated Theories. Yet to be proven.  
No actual Section A victories.

D1 - Gives complicated bizarre advice regarding other people's lawsuits but can't seem to give one example of having successfully used that strategy themselves.

D2 - Evasive / never seems to actually answer questions.

D3 - Won't willingly disclose Section A results (if any)

D4 - Doesn't like to be questioned / ridicules people when questioned.

D5 - Turns the tables. Sulks. Get spiteful.

## Section E

Harmless but meaningless advise.  
The following philosophies will have no effect in solving a lawsuit.  
Be sure to instead learn from somebody who has achieved a Section A victory.

E1 - "Don't worry, it's all an illusion anyway."

E2 - "Don't worry, after all, money's not real"

E3 - "They can't do anything to you, it's all just fiction."

E4 - "Don't play their game."

E5 - Or something similar

**Warning! Remember!**

**Problems are real. Arrest Warrants are real. Jail Cells are real.**

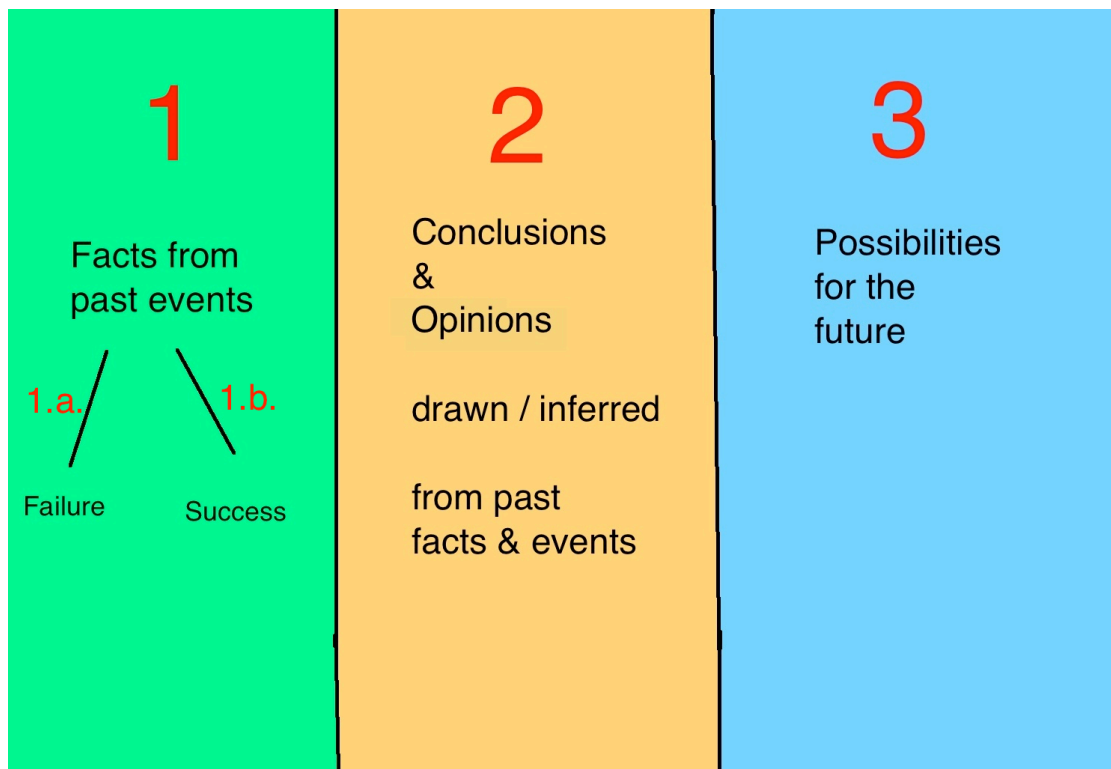
# Sovereignty Information Standards Time Line

I strictly distinguish between “**Facts from the Past**” and “**Possibilities for the Future**”.

I am generally only interested in discussing **1.b.** Successful factual stories from the past and learning what worked. Hypothetical possibilities for the future sound great but are worth very little. **Possibilities for the future** Is what cowards resort to when they won't admit they've got nothing in **1.b.** to talk about.

Anybody with a success from the past has a right to talk & teach.

Anybody with no success from the past has a duty to either ask questions or be quiet.
